

PSR ADVISORY BOARD MEETING  
May 10, 2010

The regular monthly meeting of the Parish School of Religion Advisory Board was held on Monday, May 10, 2010. Those attending were Parish Administrator Father Osang Idagbo, Coordinator Anita Toth, Chairperson Staci Wittenauer, and Board members Lynne Mitchell, Mary Shields, and Lois Thompson.

Following the opening prayer by Father Osang, details were finalized for the Closing Mass to be held on Wednesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>. Catechists, students, and parents have been advised to arrive at 6:15 pm in order to participate in praying the Rosary before the Mass begins. The Board approved the purchase of 150 small plants to be used as student gifts after the Closing Mass. As in the past, any left- over plants will be planted in the flower beds in front of the Church.

The Board approved a change in issuing of report cards for the coming school year. Report cards will be given to students three times during the year, instead of quarterly. The dates will be determined by the 2010-2011 school calendar.

The Board approved an expenditure for Saints DVD's to be purchased from Ignatius Press. Father Osang reviewed the list of possible choices and indicated which DVD's would be most useful and appropriate. The DVD's will be catalogued and made available for Catechists to check out for classroom use.

The Family Mass Coordinator, Lois Thompson, reported that in the 2010-2011 school year she will be included in the SPPS internal e-mail system. Principal Lisa Buchheit suggested that this would facilitate communication with faculty and parents when organizing participants for the Family Masses. Father Osang requested that at future Family Masses, the students sit together as a class in the first few pews.

Mary Shields advised the Board that she will be unable to fulfill the remainder of her term on the Advisory Board. With gratitude for her year of service to the Board, her resignation was accepted. There are now two vacancies on the Advisory Board and nominations are currently being accepted.

There being no further business, Father Osang closed the meeting with prayer. The next meeting is scheduled for July 12, 2010. There will be no meeting in June.
